## Cladocalyx (Eucalyptus cladocalyx F. Muell.)



Growth area: Australia and cultivated in South-Africa.

Trees: The trunk can get a height of about 25m on

average with a diameter of about 90-100cm.

Description: The wood is yellowish till honey-brown of colour

and difficult to distinguish from Tallowwood.

Figure: Interlocked grain.

Machining: Is easy to machine.

Gluing: Well.

Drying: Can be dried easily.

Fixation: Keeps nails and screws well. Pre-drilling is

necessary.

Durability: Class I, termite resistant.

Density: Unseasoned 1250 - 1300 kg/m3; Moisture content 12%: 1050 kg/m3.

Bending strength: 140 N/mm2 (moisture content 12-15%, measurement till rupture).

Modulus of elasticity: 19000 N/mm2 (Moisture content 12-15%).

Applications: Heavy constructions, exterior joinery, posts, piles, fencing, sleepers, garden furniture

and flooring.
