Punctata (Eucalyptus punctata DC.)



Growth area: Australia and cultivated in South-Africa.

Trees: The trunk can get a height of about 35m on

average with a diameter of about 90-100cm.

Description: The wood is red-brown to red of colour.

Figure: Interlocked grain.

Machining: Is easy to machine.

Gluing: Well, surface preparation necessary.

Drying: Can be dried well.

Fixation: Keeps nails and screws well. Pre-drilling is

necessary.

Durability: Class I, termite resistant.

Density: Unseasoned 1250 kg/m3; Moisture content 12%: 1050 kg/m3.

Bending strength: 140 N/mm2 (moisture content 12-15%, measurement till rupture).

Modulus of elasticity: 18000 N/mm2 (Moisture content 12-15%).

Applications: Heavy constructions, mine studs, sleepers, piles, flooring, decking.
